Our dedicated staff will continue to take every precaution to ensure the safety &well being of our children.

Safety Guidelines MASKS

In accordance with the Health & Safety guidelines at this point in time, procedural masks are not required at school or on school transportation for all students & staff

(unless prescribed by Public Health when presenting symptoms or during isolation/symptoms monitoring period).

However, masks will be available for students and staff members who wish to wear one.

On going measures

Communication

School Messenger is the mass notification system used by the school Mass notifications by Email to parents

School Messenger will be used to send the school's Newsletters and Memos to keep you informed.

It will also be used in communicating to parents important updates regarding health measures and Santé Publique guidelines. **Please verify your emails regularly.**

Note that certain email systems store these mass communication in the SPAM Box. Once you allow School Messenger as a recognized contact, it will store it in your regular inbox.

Mass notification by phone calls to parents

School Messenger will be used to send automated phone messages:

- When Busses are delayed in the afternoon (message will be sent ONLY to concerned parents (by bus#))
- When School will be closed due to wheater conditions (message sent to ALL parents)

** Since the system will be used regularly by the school, we ask that parents keep the school secretary informed promptly of any changes to the email address or phone numbers.

Reporting your child absence

Please help us out! It may be hard to believe but it's often quite difficult to reach our parents... We have several numbers to try for each child and are often forced to leave a message and hope for a reply.

Kindly report your child's absence via our school's answering machine by leaving us his/her name and the reason. You may do so at any time of the day or night. 514-845-8031

Reminder: Parents are asked to contact the school when their child is showing symptoms of COVID and/or has received a positive COVID diagnostic.

Insurances


IMPORTANT REMINDER:
